

McCormick-Lewis Scholarships are available to Rose Hill High School graduates who have successfully completed at least nine hours of post-secondary studies during the fall semester and are enrolled in a comparable program for the spring. Students can be enrolled in a two-year college, four-year college, graduate school, or a vocational/technical program. Scholarships may be renewed beyond the recipient's first year of post-secondary education based upon continued satisfactory performance.

This year's scholarships will be in the amount of \$1,000 each. Every application submitted must be accompanied by an official copy of **all** post-secondary credits to be eligible for a scholarship award. Applications are available at the Rose Hill High School Counselors office, Rose Hill Schools, USD 394 Administrative Center and on the District's website at www.usd394.com. Click on the high school tab, then counselors' tab, then information and scholarships.
